- The student of the college are guided and counseled regarding gender equity through one act play, street shows & rallies.


**C) Common room:-**






## Rule and regulations of hostel

- १) वसतिगृह प्रमुखांच्या पुर्व संमती शिवाय विद्यार्थीनीला अनुपस्थित राहता येणार नाही.
- २) वसतिगृह प्रमुखांच्या पुर्व सहमती शिवाय विद्यार्थीनीने बाहेर जाऊ नये.







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### Summary of the Event

On dated 10<sup>th</sup> October 2022, one day Health Camp was organized by women cell, Microbiology department and Health care unit of Mrs. K.S.K. College in collaboration with Sonajirao Kshirsagar Homeopathic Medical College Beed at village Bahirwadi. The event was conducted at the Z.P. Primary School playground. The programme was divided as follows;

1. Women cell-Guest lecture on the topic Women Health and medical check-up of women.
2. Microbiology Dept.-Blood group detection
3. Health care unit-Medical check- up of primary school students and other blood investigation.

To celebrate World Mental Health Day, a guest lecture of Hon. Dr. Sudam Mogale was organised on the topic of Woman Health. While addressing the audience he said that in India, the suicide percentage of women is more than men. Coming to the reasons of the ill health of women he explained that as far as Beed district is concerned it is identified as a supplier of sugarcane cutter labour to the nearby States. It is a tiresome and hectic work to them. The fatigue and stress of the work is turned into the habit of alcoholic drinks. In this situation, housewives at home are under tremendous stress. Another main reason of stress in the life history of woman is that before each menstrual cycle girls and women have to face premenstrual syndrome or stress due to hormonal imbalance. He added that during pregnancy also women has to face tensions and burden. After the occurrence of menopause woman may suffer from uterine cancer and may suffer from mental pressure.

Further he advised that healthy girls and women suffer minimum mental stress with their ability to handle it in a proper way. Thus one should follow healthy lifestyle habits in day to day life. i.e. early to bed, early to rise will benefit oneself from the natural ozone gas in the atmosphere, regular exercise, balanced diet, nutritious food choice with fibrous foods, calcium, protein, vitamin D3, iron, B12 etc., proper outfits, avoiding palm oil intake are major key factors to attain fitness.

## Session- I

Everywhere she has to defend herself. Typical patriarchal system is deeply rooted in Indian society. It is sad to note that it's followed at present nationally and internationally. For example, Kiran Bedi, Indira Gandhi, Mother Teresa etc. Ability of women, education of women, participation of women and political will are important factors to enhance status of women in India. Topic: Rural Status of women in India

Dr. Bhillare was the President of the session. While addressing participants, he focused rural women and girls. He spoke that the status of rural women reflects an even darker narrative. Out of 135 crore population in India, 65.13 percent live in rural setups and women constitute 48 percent of the total rural population. 74.8 percent of women are agricultural workers, but only 9.8 percent own a piece of land as per 2020 records. They are deprived of certain rights and opportunities and are required to wholeheartedly dedicate themselves to the implementation of household responsibilities. Rural women are at high risk of abuse, sexual harassment and other forms of gender-based violence.

## **SESSION III**

**Principal Savita Shete**

**Topic: Gender Equality: Empowerment of Women and Girls**

Principal Savita Shete delivered a lecture on gender equality. She said sex is biological but gender is not biological because it can be changed due to scientific advancement. Sexual organs are derived from chromosomes XX for girls and XY for boys. These days society is expecting too many things from brides such as well education, beautiful, handsome salaries and good packaged, healthier for doing household chores, calm and quiet by nature. Social system should adopt gender equality but since birth girls are facing from gender bias attitude and behaviour in India. Gender equality should start from home. One should be a human rather than a man or woman. Gender discrimination is high in India. Basic needs like cooking, washing clothes, and dishes, maintenance of cleanliness and hygiene of surrounding and following healthy habits should be taught to girls and boys in the family. Each woman must have same honour and respect as every man in family, community and society. She further said that girls and women are also responsible to widen the gap as they keep mum and tolerate the discrimination. This is

the main reason that gender biased activities are happening more often in society. Highly educated and employed women are also suffering from discrimination in their families and at work places regarding caste, religion, and family rituals like keeping fasting inspite of her willingness. It is must for women to not to fear anyone. She also told about importance of different Indian laws noting that implementation is not proper. She advised participants to empower themselves to say no for anything which is against their will.

**Topic: ‘Educational Status of Women, issues and concerns**

Prof. Sandip Choudhary delivered a lecture on the topic ‘Educational Status of Women, issues and concerns’. While insisting about statistics of the topic, he said that nearly 5 million women are unable to read in India. Tribal people are having their mother tongue in which the school syllabus and teaching-learning is not available. So the education policy should be friendly towards them incorporating syllabus in their mother tongue. He suggested that NGOs, different organizations, schools and colleges should come forward to educate women and girls in an online mode and through informal education if they are having difficulty in attending scheduled formal school education.

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### Summary of the Event

She said that in India there are no separate laws constituted for man and woman. Rather Constitution has formulated laws for the betterment and discipline in society and to prevent discrimination. Laws are against the deep rooted evil superstitions and prejudices existing in the society.She explained about Dowry prevention act-398, 498 A, Family violence act, Sakhi Centre which has been established by September 2022, Sexual harassment prevention, redressal and complaint for working women at work places, equal wages act, poxo act for sexual assault of girls below 18 years,Hindu Property act for girls and women as a legal heirs for their parents property, 292 and 294 act for sexual assault , illegal messages, gestures and behaviour.She stated role of State women Commission is very important, direct and impartial towards accused women.

Advocate Varsha Dalvi expressed her views about poxo act in detail.She stated that according to the information provided by family surveys in India rising figures of divorce are from the family where age of married women is below 18. Maximum number is confirmed by college girls.She informed about 494 act as it secured the marriage if the husband got married to second woman, if the documents of second marriage are provided to the court.She said that in majority cases sexual matters get resolved by monetary gain.Babysitting arrangements are lagally provided to the mother prisoner. 

Gender Audit report for College is conducted by Women Cell for the year 2022-23, as it is an essential component of the assessment and accreditation of higher education institutes as suggested by UGC.

By identifying critical gender gaps and challenges the audit also establish a base line against which progress can be measured over time, and recommendations made of how they can be addressed through improvements. There is no standard approach for carrying out gender audit. Self-analysis of the college is carried out reviewing the existing infrastructure and available data. Gender equality is human right. The Internal Complaint Committee has been formulated as per the government guidelines, the same is reported to the Maharashtra State, Joint Director (Higher education), Aurangabad Division, from time to time. ## 2) Awareness of about functioning of ICC

Separate office room is provided for ICC in college campus to maintain confidentiality. Annual plan is prepared in the very first meeting at the start of academic year. It is then submitted to IQAC Office for approval and review.

In each Semester two meetings are conducted by ICC. Yearly Four meetings are conducted. For each meeting, meeting notice is circulated among the members. Agenda of the meeting is decided. According to agenda ICC members express their views and opinion. During meeting minutes of the meeting are written down in the register. There is a discussion about future activities. The responsibilities of future programs is distributed among members for the success of program. Prior to execute each actual program plan, the program plan is discussed with Hon. Principal and vice principal. Mostly the programs are centered towards sensitizing students about sexual harassment and gender balance.

- At the end of each semester the activity report of ICC is monitored by the Principal, vice principal & IQAC.

Prior to program, the notice about venue, time and program date is circulated among staff members and students WhatsApp group. During program the participants are allowed to ask their doubts about the topic. For each activity the event report is prepared in a format with the GPS photo for a proof. Number of the participants present for the program were listed with their signatures. The activity report of all the activities is submitted to the IQAC at the end of the academic year. It is then uploaded on the College website.

There is no any serious gender issue till now. Sometimes miscellaneous verbal complaints do take place, but it is resolved by present faculty members over there.

**Procedure for Sexual Complaint:** Written complaint of sexual harassment at workplace is obtained by ICC, within a period of three months from the date of the

incident. If needed any member of ICC shall render all reasonable assistance to the woman or girl for making the complaint in writing.

ICC, before initiating an inquiry under Section 11 and at the request of the sufferer woman or girl take steps to settle the matter between her and the respondents. If settlement is arrived at under Sub-Section (1), the ICC shall record the settlement so far arrived and forward the same to the Principal to take action as specified in the recommendation. ICC, then provide the copies of settlement as recorded under Sub Section(1), no further inquiry shall be conducted by the ICC closing the issue henceforth.

**Inquiry into Complaint:** Subject to the provisions of Section 10, the ICC, proceed to make inquiry into the complaint in accordance with the provisions of the service rules applicable to the respondent, where the respondent is an employee.

Provided further that where both the practices are employees, the parties shall during the course of inquiry, be given an opportunity of being heard and a copy of the findings shall be made available to both the parties enabling them to make representation against the findings before the committee. Further procedure will be followed as per the legal provisions recommendations stated in the Gazette of India, Government of India about the sexual harassment of women at workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013, published by Legislative Department of Ministry of Law and Justice.

The enquiry shall be completed within a period of ninety days, is mandatory.

#### **Other good practices to promote gender equity-**

##### **Gender Sensitive Activities organized in the college:**

Special Measures College has taken for safety of students like appointing women staff for college hostel, CCTV surveillance facility, four complaint boxes are situated for students to drop written complaint in it. College has good connecting roads within the campus and outside the campus too. Satisfactory light arrangement is available during night time also. College building has four male toilets and three female toilets with disposable bins. College also has following committees for safeguarding the interests of students as well as male & female staff.

1. Student's grievance redressal committee.
2. Anti- ragging committee.
3. Discipline committee.
4. ICC/Internal Complaint Committee/Women Cell

The college concentrates on student's qualitative performance & there by overall personality development. Equal opportunity is offered to male and female in Class room, library and laboratory. The NSS unit in college motivates male & female students for their social responsibilities. Special reading room, parking area and sports training is provided for the girls. Also, separate queues are followed. On administrative counters during admission period. Girls are given self-defence training in college campus.

The lectures of eminent personalities are held on various topics to develop their personalities. (List of various activities is presented in **Annexure**).

The college conducts orientation program for the first year students at the start of first semester Workshops & webinars are held on "Women & Laws" to make girls aware of their rights & responsibilities. Regular lectures & programs are organized on different women related issues. Special lectures are organized to deal with dietary needs during adolescence. 


**Figure No. 1**

**Gender wise details of total HODs' in college**

















**Gender wise distribution of N.C.C. Students**





### Sau. Kesharbai Sonajirao Kshirsagar Girls' Hostel :

One more major asset is ladies hostel within the college campus since 2010. It is three floors building with 45 rooms having capacity of residence of 2-3 girls in the same room's i.e total intake of 100 girls and 60 girls students are residing in the hostel in year 2022-23.

#### Salient features of Ladies Hostel:

1. Presence of 24 hour security guard.
2. Except unavoidable circumstances no body is allowed to enter after 7p.m.
3. Daily movement register is maintained.
4. It consists of 21 toilet & 21 bathrooms and 24 hr water supply is observed. Two attendants are looking after it's cleanliness daily.

1. Inverter facility is present during no electricity supply due to load shading or other reasons sometimes it is not working.
2. Prof. Anita Shinde is residing in the hostel with her family as a Hostel Warden. During her working hours in the college Ms. Sonali Shahane has been appointed during day time.
3. RO Water purifier system is available for safe drinking water purpose.
4. Solar water heating system is also available for girls.
5. In door entertainment hall is available in the ground floor facilitating TV, Carom, chess & Badminton court as outdoor facility.
6. For each floor one i.e. 3 CCTV units & 2 CCTV units for ground floor i.e. total 5 CCTV cameras are present & functioning to avoid any nuisance one complain box is situated.
7. Good quality local mess is present to maintain food hygiene of hostellers.
8. First aid box & medical officers are appointed for medical service to the residing girls.
9. College Management principal, college anti ragging committee, College advisory committee is keeping eye on activities of ladies hostel so, till today no major issue has occurred in this hostel except some miscellaneous complains which were sorted out at that time.

### Boys Hostel:

Boy's hostel building is present with the capacity of 25 boy's residence.

### Library:


Our library is one of the best educational library in Marathwada region. There is separate well equipped reading hall for 50 girls. It is facilitated with daily newspaper, reading books & journals. It has one toilet & bathroom in the building itself with 24 by 7 water supply. It has 24 hour guard security, inverter back up availability & CCTV Surveillance for safety purpose. Separate que is strictly followed for male & female students during issuing books.

### RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. To introduce self-employment trainings in different subjects.
2. Number of ladies washrooms should be increased in the College.

### Conclusion:

It is found that College has lots of strengths and some weaknesses which can overcome easily. There is no gender issue complaint due to the adoption of proper safety and security measures and awareness of all faculty members, the miscellaneous complaints of students are resolved on the spot.
